

Notice to All Pressurized Irrigation Users

Because of construction at the Beaver City Power and Irrigation intake above the golf course, there will be no pressurized irrigation water available after October 1, 2016. Lower ditch water users will be able to receive water through the old ditch diversion in the Beaver River after this time. If you have any questions, please call the Beaver City Office at 438-2451 or the Beaver City Water Master Chad Limb at 310-0550.

At present, there is plenty of water for all to use. All water users are encouraged to use the water carefully, wisely, and efficiently. For the months of April and May, water may be used as the weather dictates. In June, July and August, the irrigation water will be limited to no sprinkling between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. New lawn and sod is best established in the spring and fall. It is too hot and there is not enough water to establish new lawns in the heat of the summer. All pressurized irrigation users are encouraged to stay with the watering schedules they have had in the past keeping the above suggestions in mind.
