

The **Beaver City Council** met in a **Special Meeting** at **6:00 p.m.** in the Beaver City Center on Tuesday, **March 3, 2016**. The following members of the Council were present: Mayor Craig Wright, Council Members Connie Fails, Tyler Schena, and Chad McWilliams. Council Members Matt Robinson and Robin Bradshaw were excused. Also present was City Recorder Anona Yardley.

GOLF COURSE CONCESSIONAIRE

Mayor Wright handed out the estimated income and expenses for the golf course of 2000 that was provided by the concessionaire during that time. The proposed concessionaire's wish list was presented and discussed. The wage and expenses associated with employment by Beaver City were discussed. The hourly wages of all golf course employees were discussed. The council asked the prospective concessionaire to visit with them. The kitchen freezer and refrigerator were discussed. The hourly wage was discussed. The overtime issue was addressed. Specifics of running the restaurant were discussed. There could be a re-evaluation period in June to see if there would need to be another employee. There may need to be more part-time help to cover the shifts. The FY2017 budget will be reviewed during the first council meeting in June. The beer license needs to be to the state by March 10th in order for it to be on the docket for the March 22nd meeting. The account for Nicholas will be set up tomorrow. A dumpster will be ordered for the kitchen. An account with Pepsi also will be needed. The prospective concessionaire will make a decision tonight about taking the position or not and let the mayor know in the morning.

GOLF COURSE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE

The list of equipment purchased by the former concessionaire was read and discussed. The list of equipment that is needed to purchase was enumerated. Council Member McWilliams moved and Council Member Schena seconded to trade the amount the former concessionaire owes to Beaver City for cell bills and insurance for the inventory list already in the clubhouse, minus the books. All voted in favor. None Opposed. The council went to the kitchen to look at the cooler and freezer in the City Center kitchen. Mayor Wright signed the cart rental agreement that was approved at the last council meeting.

Council Member Fails moved and Council Member McWilliams seconded to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None opposed. The Council Meeting was adjourned at 7:58 p.m. The next Council meeting will be held Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.
