

The **Beaver City Council** met in a **Special Meeting** at **8:00 p.m.** in the Beaver City Center located at 30 West 300 North on Tuesday, **June 20, 2017**. The following members of the Council were present: Mayor Craig Wright, Council Members Robin Bradshaw, Connie Fails, Chad McWilliams, Tyler Schena, and Matt Robinson. Also present were City Manager Jason Brown, Treasurer Paul Barton, and City Recorder Anona Yardley.

FY2018 PROPOSED BUDGET ADOPTION

This meeting was convened in order to comply with the State Ordinance of adopting the FY2018 budget before June 22, 2017. Manager Brown reviewed the revisions of the budget after the public hearings held in the last Council meeting. Council Member Bradshaw addressed the Council about wages for the City Manager. Council Member Bradshaw moved and Council Member Robinson seconded to increase the City Manager’s wages in the FY2018 and receive a step increase to Grade 25 Step 5 as the present personnel manual indicates effective July 1, 2017. All voted in favor. None opposed. Council Member Bradshaw moved and Council Member Fails seconded to approve the FY2018 budget as presented. The wages for the City Manager have been included in the FY2018 Budget as presented. All voted in favor. None opposed. Council Member McWilliams moved and Council Member Schena seconded to accept the transfers from utility funds to the general fund as presented in the FY2018 Budget. All voted in favor. None opposed.

July 4th Preparations

Council Member Bradshaw asked that the Council take a few minutes and review the particulars of the Beaver City July 4th Celebration. The National Anthem will be sung with flag flying. Have Retreat played to lower the flag. As the flag is retired, the fireworks will begin. Manager Brown will help with flags. Council Member McWilliams will be in charge of the timing and scheduling of the event. Mayor Wright is in charge of the Fireworks Show. Council Member Robinson is in charge of the food. Mayor Wright will order the buns. Council Member Fails will purchase the condiments. Mayor Wright will provide the hot dog trays. Council Member Bradshaw will get the clean trough and water. The trailer for the band will be parked by the northwest field. The band will begin playing at 7:30 p.m. The hot dogs will be ready by 7:00 p.m. There were some concerns with the fireworks show.

Cemetery on Memorial Day

The Council complimented the City Crew for their work on the cemetery before and after Memorial Day. Mayor Wright read a letter from a Beaver City citizen complimenting the City crews on the beautiful cemetery.

Council Member McWilliams moved and Council Member Fails seconded to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None opposed. The Council Meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m. The next regularly scheduled Council meeting will be held Tuesday, June 27, 2017 at 4:00 p.m.
