RECITALS

By completing this application, applicant enters into a legally binding and enforceable agreement with Beaver City, State of Utah, in accordance with the following provisions:

- 1: Applicant hereby agrees to submit an application fee as set by the City Council at the time of making application, which fee will be fully refunded if the application is not approved.
- 2: Applicant agrees by signing this application that he / she relinquishes all ownership and control to Beaver City of water lines which he / she currently owns which are necessary to distribute water in accordance with the foregoing request for connection, up to and including metering device and meter box.
- 3: Applicant hereby agrees to grant Beaver City all easements and rights-of-way which are necessary to properly and adequately operate and maintain all distribution lines which lie within the boundaries of applicant's real property.

- 4: In accordance with Utah Public Drinking Water Regulations, Section 12:0-1 Beaver City cannot supply water with less than 20 p.s.i. of pressure to the applicant. This pressure is approximately equal to a minimum of 46.18 feet of elevation difference between the bottom of the storage tank and the water hook-up.
- 5: Beaver City Corporation, acting pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, Section 10-8-4 (1953, as amended), is limited to delivery of surplus culinary water only outside its corporate city limits. APPLICANT HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGES THE FACT THAT HE / SHE IS OBTAINING FROM BEAVER CITY ONLY A SURPLUS CULINARY WATER SUPPLY WHICH IS INTERRUPTIBLE AND MAY BE DISCONTINUED ENTIRELY DURING UNFORSEEN EXTREME WATER SHORTAGES.
- 6: Applicant hereby agrees to abide by any and all regulations lawfully adopted by Beaver City in regard to water use extended as a result of this application.
- 7: Applicant further agrees that it is his / her sole responsibility to maintain and repair in an orderly fashion all privately-owned water lines, on customer's side of the meter, that provide water services under the provisions of this application.
- 8: In the event that water lines become deteriorated, broken, etc., and have not been maintained in an orderly fashion, applicant agrees that Beaver City can terminate water service until such time as applicant demonstrates that he / she has repaired or replaced the lines to the satisfaction of Beaver City.
- 9: Beaver applicant does not reside within the corporate boundaries of Beaver City, and therefore, is not subject to city taxes and assessments, applicant agrees that he / she may be subject to payment of legally adopted in order to cover any additional uncompensated costs of extraterritorial water service.
- 10: The services and rights granted pursuant to this application are non-transferable and may be discontinued by either party by giving the other party reasonable notice of intent to terminate.
- 11: Beaver City reserves the right to accept or reject this application for any justification within its lawful discretion.
