

The **Beaver City Council** met in a **Special Meeting** at **8:00 p.m.** in the Beaver City Center located at 30 West 300 North on **Tuesday, July 31, 2018**. The following members of the Council were present: Mayor Matt Robinson, Council Members Connie Fails, Alison Webb, Tyler Schena, Robin Bradshaw, and Hal Murdock. Also present were City Manager Jason Brown and City Recorder Anona Yardley.

CHRISTMAS LIGHT DISCUSSION AND PURCHASE

Council Member Bradshaw has obtained Christmas Light quotes from Northern Lights, Display Sales, Modern Display, Novelty Lights, and Mosca Design. He looked for something different to cross Main Street. He recommended that every other pole be a lighted garland and every other pole be a lighted swag and snowflake. The lights needed to be LED lights in order to pull less power. For the trees on Main Street he wondered if green lights would be better than white and make half of trees blink on and off. The words “Merry Christmas” would be on each end of Main Street. The hospital will be buy one of the Merry Christmas and another individual wanted to buy the other. The Travel Council will be able to pay for the poles that would hold the signs. After all the donations from individuals, entities, the City would need to pay approximately \$13,000. The four poles at the end of Main Street would be concreted in the ground in order to hang the Merry Christmas. There are many people that have pledged \$1,000 for this project. Council Members discussed funding and where to adjust the budget in order for the lights to be purchased. After considering the extent of the project and the possible donators, Council Member Schena motioned and Council Member Murdock seconded to approve the purchase of the Christmas lights as shown on Quote #4 from Mosca Design. All voted in favor. None opposed.

Council Member Fails motioned and Council Member Schena seconded to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None opposed. The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
