

The **Beaver City Council** met in an **Emergency Meeting at 9:00 p.m.** in the Beaver City Center located at 30 West 300 North on **Friday, March 13, 2020**. The following members of the Council were present: Mayor Matt Robinson, Council Members Alison Webb, Tyler Schena, Lance Cox, and Hal Murdock. Council Member Bradshaw joined the meeting by telephone. Also present were City Manager Jason Brown and City Recorder Anona Yardley. Angela Edwards, Librarian and Stacey Phelps, Swimming Pool Director were also present.

DISCUSS COVID19 PRECAUTIONS WITHIN BEAVER CITY

Mayor Robinson's first concern was for the health and well-being of the Beaver City residents and Beaver City's liability when following the State of Utah's recommendations in regard to COVID19. With these and other questions in mind, Mayor Robinson read a letter implementing Beaver City's response to Governor Herbert's recommendations. They were as follows:

1. The swimming pool will be closed until the morning of March 30 to do deep cleaning and sterilization measures and open with limited occupancy thereafter.
2. The library will be closed for deep cleaning until Monday, March 30 and limit occupancy to the current guidelines thereafter.
3. The Beaver City Offices will be closed to the public until March 30 with all staff working full time and performing their normal duties. Communications will be by telephone, text and email. Social distancing will be observed with all city employees.
4. All utility disconnects will be temporarily suspended for 30 days.
5. All Beaver City activities will be visited on an individual basis and decide at that time if it will be cancelled.

Librarian Angela Edwards would like to have a curb side service for book renewal and delivery. Pool manager Stacey Phelps will do some filter cleaning and disinfecting. The punch passes for Wendy Macdonald's are expired because they were an incentive and no money was exchanged. These changes will take effect Monday, March 16, 2020. A notice will be posted on all City buildings, on Facebook and the City website.

Council Member Cox motioned and Council Member Schena seconded to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None opposed. The Council Meeting was adjourned at 10:00 p.m. The next scheduled Council meeting will be held Tuesday, April 14, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.
