

MEET UTAH JAZZ LEGEND

JEFF MALONE

Jeff Malone played college basketball at Mississippi State and was drafted 10th overall in the 1983 NBA draft by the Washington Bullets. Playing the shooting guard position, he averaged over 19 points during 13 years in the NBA. A two time NBA All-Star in 1986 and 1987, he played for the Utah Jazz from 1990-1994. In his first year in Utah, Jeff shot 91.7% on free throws, second only to Indiana's Reggie Miller who shot 91.8%. Malone is known for his fadeaway jump shot with lethal accuracy. His scoring helped the Jazz reach the Western Conference Finals twice during his time with the team. He also won the Shooting Stars Showdown during the 1993 All-Star Weekend in Salt Lake City.
